If paper application: the presence at the sous-prefecture of the researcher is mandatory. You should bring the originals of the following documents.

Original documents must be written in French or translated by a sworn translator. File documents in the following order:

- Currently valid passport: ID page + photocopies of all pages with visas, stamps and writing
- Currently valid **Passeport Talent - Famille** visa
- Birth certificate specifying filiation ; child's birth certificate if applicable
- Civil union / registered partnership / marriage certificate
- Ephoto code (Ephotos are available in most photo booths, see link afterward). In case you deposit a paper application, you'll need 3 passport photographs meeting the specific standards required by the French authorities: www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F10619
- Proofs of residence (**less than 3 months old**)
 - a) You share a flat/house with your spouse/ parent scientist: you need 2 documents. 1/ a copy of the rental agreement and 2/ a copy of a commodity bill (electricity, gas, landline telephone or internet access) or alternatively a house insurance certificate.
NB : Having both names on the rental agreement, bill or house insurance is generally necessary.
 - b) You live in a residence: only an attestation of residence will be necessary
 - c) You are hosted by a third person: signed hosting attestation + host ID (residence permit if foreign) + documents listed in point a). If owner, copy of property taxes (*impôts fonciers*)
- Residence permit of spouse/parent researcher
- Hosting agreement of spouse/parent researcher + contract
- Proof of cohabitation (*Déclaration de communauté de vie*, document available at CMI Brest).
